This is not a boring set book for school. Forefathers' Eve is a story full of panache and colors, about love stronger than death, an engaging spectacle about the division of the world into the exploiters and the exploited, and about the force of poetry that has the power to break all barriers. It's also about those gathered around Mickiewicz's brilliant work, which when passed through the universal filter of pop culture, will reveal to the public its new, witty face, full of surprising associations.
